From Burlington and North:

Take 295 South to the RT-168 S exit, EXIT 28, toward NEW JERSEY TPKE/ BELLMAWR/ RUNNEMEDE. Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto S BLACK HORSE PIKE/ NJ-168. Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto CHEWS LANDING RD/ CR-683. We are located in the CHEWS LANDING COMMONS. The REAL Center is the building to the far right of the complex.

From Gloucester County and South:

Head NORTH on BLACK HORSE PIKE/ NJ-42 N. Merge onto 42 N. Take the COLES ROAD exit toward BLENHEIM/ ALMONESSON. Keep LEFT at the fork to go on COLES RD. COLES RD becomes HIDER LN. Turn LEFT onto CHEWS LANDING RD/ CR-683. We are located in the CHEWS LANDING COMMONS. The REAL Center is the building to the far right of the complex.
